

Introduction to High Definition

Aims

This course targets non technical staff and aims to give them a general view of High Definition Television and its implications for all aspects of the broadcast business. Topics are presented in a non technical jargon free manner making them accessible to all members of the operation from finance through to human resources

Topics Covered

The course starts with a brief explanation of the common terms and meanings of the numbers used to describe television systems. It moves on to cover the relationships between human visual perception and television systems focusing on how HD improves on the visual experience over SD. Other areas covered are the progress of HD world wide and the various business/regulatory models that are being applied. Finally the course touches on the engineering, operational and creative changes that are required in the move to High Definition

Results

At the end of the course attendees should feel comfortable with all the new terms and jargon associated with the new standards. They should also have gained a broad understanding of what High Definition television is and its implications for the broadcast business

Duration,

This is normally a one day course involving traditional lecture style, interactive sessions and demonstrations where practical.
